



Contact Lens Evaluation Agreement

Contact lenses (CLs) are medical devices that can alter the health of the eye. As such, they are closely regulated by the FDA and FTC. Eye health needs to be monitored at least yearly by an Optometrist when wearing contact lenses. There are additional tests performed for contact lens wearers that are not part of routine eye care. This ensures that with contact lenses: eyes remain healthy, lenses fit properly, and vision is optimized.

I understand:

- There is a professional fee for an annual contact lens (CL) evaluation regardless of whether I am a new or continual wearer.
- CL fitting and evaluation fees are separated from routine exam benefits by my insurance.
- This CL fee may or may not be covered or discounted by my insurance.
- The fee will depend on the complexity of the lens type and specialized knowledge needed to fit the lens.
- These fees also cover any diagnostic contact lenses, training on application and removal, and all additional follow-up care needed within the first three months of a contact lens fitting/evaluation.

Fees are as follows*:

Established CL Evaluation:	\$55
Gas Permeable CL Evaluation:	\$75
Multifocal Lens Fitting (existing CL wearer):	\$125
New CL Wearer Fitting:	\$175

*Insurance or discount will be applied when applicable. **Specialty contact lens** fittings and evaluations (e.g. OrthoK, Sclerals, Hybrid lenses, etc) require further complexity, are typically not covered by insurance, and have a separate fee schedule than above.
